TO THE HONORABLE HARRY C. DANIELS, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The undersigned, ERNEST C. CHRISTIANSEN, represents that on September 13, A. D. 1946 Letters Testamentary issued to him upon his filing oath and bond as prescribed by law; that he immediately entered upon his duties as such Executor and is still so acting.

Your petitioner further represents that he made inventory of all of the assets of said estate, which inventory has been filed in and duly approved by this Court; that he has made proof of heirship and that the heirship of said decedent remains the same as originally entered except that Clarence Hepfinger named in said original proof of heirship died in October of 1947; that he has duly published for the adjudication of claims against said estate and that there is not pending in this or in any other court, on appeal or otherwise, any claim or proceeding against said estate or against said petitioner as such Executor; that all taxes have been paid and that said estate is not subject to federal estate or state inheritance taxes.

Your petitioner further represents that under the last Will of said Mary Wilhelmina Bolz specific bequests were provided for totalling Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000); that there is now available for distribution, after payment of final court costs and costs of administration, the amount of Four Hundred Forty-five and 17/100 Dollars (\$445.17); that, therefore, it was necessary to make a pro rata distribution to the legatees named in said Will and such distribution has been made and the Receipts in full or Appearances and Waivers of Notice of each

of such legatees being hereto attached and made a part hereof;
that no other person other than those whose said Receipts or
Appearances and Waivers of Notice are hereto attached is
entitled to any notice of the matter of the hearing and approval
of this Final Report and Account.

YOUR PETITIONER, THEREFORE, PRAYS that inasmuch as
more than nine months have elapsed since the granting of Letters
Testamentary herein and all claims and costs of administration
have been fully paid and there is nothing further to be done in
the premises other than the filing and approval of the Final
Report and Account; that this may be accepted as and for his
Final Report and Account; that said estate may be declared fully
settled and that he may be discharged as such Executor, his bond
declared null and void and all other court orders necessary and
proper in the premises may be entered.
